Sometime in the early 2000s Jeff Billings graduated from MIT and took a job with one of those big Silicon Valley tech companies and made the "big bucks". After about two years he realized money couldn't replace his passion for working with young people and he switched careers to become a public-school teacher in California. Eventually he made his way back home to Connecticut and took a job teaching math at Hall High School and became the legendary coach Tom Butterfield's assistant coach. When Coach Butterfield retired in 2015, Billing was the natural replacement and what was always a very successful program reached new heights.

Hall has produced countless All American relay athletes and even set the CT state record in the 1600m sprint medley on the way to winning the New Balance National Outdoor Championship in 2019. This past year, Hall became the first team in 14 years to win the "Triple Crown" of CIAC State Open titles in cross country, indoor and outdoor track. Billing's teams have accomplished all this while carrying a team of over 150 boys on the roster and providing each athlete a memorable high school experience.
